A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 588

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to evidence of motor vehicle financial responsibility;
- 3 providing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 601.053, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A person commits an offense if the person fails or
- 8 refuses to provide to a peace officer the evidence of financial
- 9 responsibility as required by Subsection (a). An offense under
- 10 this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 11 (d) A court shall dismiss a charge of an offense under
- 12 Subsection (c) if the defendant presents to the court one of the
- documents listed in Subsection (a) that was valid at the time that
- 14 the offense occurred. The court may assess the defendant an
- administrative fee not to exceed \$10 when the charge is dismissed.
- 16 Section 51.607, Government Code, does not apply to the
- 17 administrative fee.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 601, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 601.2611 to read as follows:
- 20 Sec. 601.2611. RELEASE OF VEHICLE ON PROOF OF FINANCIAL
- 21 RESPONSIBILITY IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section
- 22 applies only to a municipality that has a population of more than
- one million and is located in the metropolitan area served by a
- 24 rapid transit authority eligible to create an advanced

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- 1 transportation district under Subchapter O, Chapter 451.
- 2 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the owner or operator of a storage facility shall release a vehicle impounded at the 3 4 facility because the vehicle had been operated by a person without evidence of financial responsibility and waive the impound and 5 6 storage fees if the owner of the vehicle provides to the owner or 7 operator of the facility not later than 48 hours after the vehicle was impounded evidence of financial responsibility for the vehicle 8 that was in effect on the date the impoundment began. 9 municipality that authorized the impoundment shall pay any 10 impoundment or storage fee waived under this section. 11
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
