1	AN ACT
2	relating to the retail sale of temperature-adjusted gasoline and
3	diesel fuel.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 13, Agriculture Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 13.0241 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 13.0241. STANDARD FOR RETAIL GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL.
8	(a) Notwithstanding Section 13.024, the unit of measure of capacity
9	for gasoline and diesel fuel sold at retail is the
10	temperature-adjusted gallon.
11	(b) One temperature-adjusted gallon of gasoline is an
12	amount equal to one gallon of gasoline at a temperature of 60
13	degrees Fahrenheit.
14	(c) One temperature-adjusted gallon of diesel fuel is an
15	amount equal to one gallon of diesel fuel at a temperature of 60
16	degrees Fahrenheit.
17	(d) Each pump used for the retail sale of gasoline or diesel
18	fuel shall:
19	(1) measure the temperature of the gasoline or diesel
20	fuel being dispensed; and
21	(2) measure in temperature-adjusted gallons.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2008.
