22	another trustee holds a position.
23	(b-1) To be eligible to serve in the third elected position
24	on the board, a person must be a retiree.

1 SECTION 2. At the trustee election held by the Employees 2 Retirement System of Texas to fill a position on the board of 3 trustees that expires August 31, 2007, the members and retirees of 4 the retirement system shall elect a trustee who meets the 5 eligibility requirements of Section 815.003(b-1), Government Code, 6 as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
