## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the ability of an honorably retired reserve peace

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 46.15, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a)(5), an honorably retired
- 8 peace officer:
- 9 <u>(1) is not required to hold a permanent peace officer</u>
- 10 license issued under Chapter 1701, Occupations Code; and
- 11 (2) includes an honorably retired reserve peace
- 12 <u>officer.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 1701.357(b), Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (b) The head of a state or local law enforcement agency may
- 16 allow an honorably retired peace officer, including an honorably
- 17 <u>retired reserve peace officer</u>, an opportunity to demonstrate
- 18 weapons proficiency if the retired officer provides to the agency a
- 19 sworn affidavit stating that:
- 20 (1) the officer honorably retired after not less than
- 21 a total of 15 years of service as a commissioned officer with one or
- 22 more state or local law enforcement agencies;
- 23 (2) the officer's license as a commissioned officer
- 24 was not revoked or suspended for any period during the officer's

- 1 term of service as a commissioned officer; and
- 2 (3) the officer has no psychological or physical
- 3 disability that would interfere with the officer's proper handling
- 4 of a handgun.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
