- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 43.121(a), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The governing body of a home-rule municipality [with
- 8 more than 225,000 inhabitants] by ordinance may annex an area for
- 9 the limited purposes of applying its planning, zoning, health, and
- 10 safety ordinances in the area if the municipality:
- 11 (1) has a population of more than 225,000; or
- 12 (2) has a population of more than 17,500 and is located
- in a county adjacent to a county with a population of more than 1.4
- 14 million.
- 15 SECTION 2. The section heading to Section 43.121, Local
- 16 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 43.121. AUTHORITY OF CERTAIN [POPULOUS] HOME-RULE
- 18 MUNICIPALITIES TO ANNEX FOR LIMITED PURPOSES; OTHER AUTHORITY NOT
- 19 AFFECTED.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
