## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain retired peace officers to
- 3 obtain a weapons proficiency certificate.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.357(c), Occupations Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The agency shall establish written procedures for the
- 8 issuance or denial of a certificate of proficiency under this
- 9 section. The agency shall issue the certificate to a retired
- 10 officer who satisfactorily demonstrates weapons proficiency under
- 11 Subsection (b), provides proof that the officer is entitled to
- 12 receive a pension or annuity for [receiving retirement benefits on
- 13 the basis of service with a state or local law enforcement agency
- or is not entitled to receive a pension or annuity only because the
- 15 law enforcement agency that employed the retired officer does not
- offer a pension or annuity to its retired employees, and satisfies
- 17 the written procedures established by the agency. The agency shall
- 18 maintain records of any retired officer who holds a certificate
- 19 issued under this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an application for a weapons proficiency certificate under
- 22 Section 1701.357, Occupations Code, filed on or after September 1,
- 23 2007. An application for a weapons proficiency certificate under
- 24 Section 1701.357, Occupations Code, filed before September 1, 2007,

- 1 is covered by the law in effect on the date the application was
- 2 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
