- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 257.002, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-2) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1) or (d-2), a [A]
- 9 person whose license has been expired for one year or more may not
- 10 renew the license. The person may obtain a new license by complying
- 11 with the requirements and procedures, including the examination
- 12 requirements, for obtaining an original license.
- 13 (d-2) The board may renew the license of a person whose
- 14 license has been expired for one year or more without requiring the
- 15 person to comply with the requirements and procedures for an
- original license if the person places the person's renewed license
- on retired status and confines the person's practice solely to
- voluntary charity care under Section 256.102(f).
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
