- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 659.012, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) Notwithstanding the salary limitation provided by
- 8 Subsection (a)(1) and notwithstanding any other law, a district
- 9 judge who presides over at least one proceeding transferred to a
- 10 <u>district court under Subchapter H, Chapter 74, in a state fiscal</u>
- 11 year is entitled to the same increase in annual salary from the
- 12 state for that fiscal year as a local administrative district judge
- is entitled to under Subsection (d). Notwithstanding any other
- 14 law, supplemental compensation paid to a district judge under this
- 15 subsection is not included as part of the district judge's total
- 16 annual salary for purposes of computing another salary that is
- 17 based on the salary of the district judge.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
