## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the fraudulent use of a child's identifying

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.51(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) A person commits an offense if the person, with intent
- 8 to harm or defraud another, obtains, possesses, transfers, or uses
- 9 identifying information of:
- 10 (1) another person without the other person's consent;
- 11 or
- 12 (2) a child younger than 18 years of age [and with
- 13 <u>intent to harm or defraud another</u>].
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 18 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 19 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 20 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 21 before that date.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
