9	least twice the minimum fine applicable to the offense and not more								
10	than twice the maximum fine that is applicable to the offense if the								
11	person who commits the offense is at the time of the offense								
12	operating a motor vehicle while:								
13	(1) reading;								
14	(2) writing;								
15	(3) performing personal grooming;								
16	(4) consuming food or a beverage;								
17	(5) interacting with a pet;								
18	(6) interacting with a vehicle passenger;								
19	(7) using a personal communications device; or								
20	(8) engaging in another activity that prevents the								
21	operator from safely operating the motor vehicle.
