## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a pilot project to develop and operate a crisis

3 stabilization unit on Kerrville State Hospital grounds.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 551, Health and Safety

6 Code, is amended by adding Section 551.009 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 551.009. HILL COUNTRY LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY

CRISIS STABILIZATION UNIT PILOT PROJECT. (a) The Department of

State Health Services shall implement a crisis stabilization unit

pilot project by establishing and operating a crisis stabilization

11 unit on the grounds of the Kerrville State Hospital as provided by

this section. The unit must be a 16-bed facility separate from the

buildings used by the Kerrville State Hospital.

14 (b) The department shall contract with the local mental

health authority serving the Hill Country area, including Kerr

County, to operate the crisis stabilization unit. The department

shall ensure that the crisis stabilization unit provides short-term

18 residential treatment, including medical and nursing services,

19 designed to reduce a patient's acute symptoms of mental illness and

20 prevent a patient's admission to an inpatient mental health

21 facility.

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(c) The local mental health authority shall contract with

23 Kerrville State Hospital to provide food service, laundry service,

lawn care, and equipment rental to the crisis stabilization unit.

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- 1 The local mental health authority may contract with Kerrville State
- 2 Hospital to provide pharmaceutical services for the crisis
- 3 stabilization unit.
- 4 (d) The crisis stabilization unit may not be used to provide
- 5 care to:
- 6 <u>(1) children; or</u>
- 7 (2) adults sentenced to a state mental facility as
- 8 provided by Chapter 46C, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 9 (e) The local mental health authority operating the crisis
- 10 stabilization unit under contract may use for the purpose of
- operating the unit money appropriated to the department for state
- 12 hospitals and allocated to the local mental health authority.
- 13 (f) The department, in collaboration with the local mental
- 14 health authority, shall ensure that the crisis stabilization unit
- 15 <u>is made available to other mental health authorities for use as</u>
- designated by the department.
- 17 (g) Not later than December 1, 2008, the Department of State
- 18 <u>Health Services shall submit a report to the governor, the</u>
- 19 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 20 representatives that includes:
- 21 (1) an analysis of the effectiveness of the pilot
- 22 project; and
- 23 (2) recommendations regarding the continuation or
- 24 expansion of the pilot project.
- 25 (h) This section expires September 1, 2009.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
