1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the membership of the governing board of the Department
1-9 of Information Resources.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Sections 2054.021(c) and (d), Government Code,
1-12 are amended to read as follows:

1-13 (c) Two groups each composed of three ex officio members
1-14 serve on the board on a rotating basis. The ex officio members
1-15 serve as nonvoting members of the board. Only one group serves at a
1-16 time. The first group is composed of the commissioner of insurance
1-17 [~~workers' compensation~~], the executive commissioner of the Health
1-18 and Human Services Commission, and the executive director of the
1-19 Texas Department of Transportation. Members of the first group
1-20 serve for two-year terms that begin February 1 of every other
1-21 odd-numbered year and that expire on February 1 of the next
1-22 odd-numbered year. The second group is composed of the
1-23 commissioner of education, the executive director of the Texas
1-24 Department of Criminal Justice, and the executive director of the
1-25 Parks and Wildlife Department. Members of the second group serve
1-26 for two-year terms that begin February 1 of the odd-numbered years
1-27 in which the terms of members of the first group expire and that
1-28 expire on February 1 of the next odd-numbered year.

1-29 (d) An ex officio member may designate an employee on the
1-30 management or senior staff level [~~the information resources~~
1-31 ~~manager~~] of the member's agency to serve in the member's place.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
