## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the form of "Welcome to Texas" signs along certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 201.617, Transportation Code, as added
- 6 by Chapter 474, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 7 2005, is amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection
- 8 (c) to read as follows:
- 9 (b) A "Welcome to Texas" sign erected by the department
- 10 must include the following elements:
- 11 (1) a depiction of the state flag; and
- 12 (2) the phrase "Drive Friendly--The Texas Way." [+
- 13 and
- 14 [(3) the phrase "Welcome to Texas--Proud to be the
- 15 Home of President George W. Bush."]
- (c) If the president of the United States is a resident of
- 17 Texas, a "Welcome to Texas" sign erected by the department must
- 18 <u>include the phrase "Welcome to Texas--Proud Home of President</u>
- 19 [insert name of the president of the United States]."
- 20 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Transportation shall
- 21 ensure that a "Welcome to Texas" sign erected by the department
- 22 before the effective date of this Act complies with this Act not
- 23 later than September 1, 2009.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 20, 2009.
