7	Sec. 413.0311. REVIEW OF CERTAIN MEDICAL DISPUTES;
8	CONTESTED CASE HEARING. (a) This section applies to a medical
9	dispute that remains unresolved after any applicable review under
10	Section 413.031, including a dispute related to:
11	(1) spinal surgery;
12	(2) health care provider fees; or
13	(3) appeal of an independent review organization
14	decision regarding determination of the medical necessity of a
15	health care service.
16	(b) A party to a medical dispute described by Subsection (a)

- is entitled to a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing under this section shall be conducted by a hearings officer in the 19 manner provided for contested case hearings under Subchapter D, Chapter 410. Notwithstanding Section 410.024, a benefit review 20 21 conference is not a prerequisite to a contested case hearing under
- 22 this section.

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23 (c) The decision of a hearings officer under this section is 24 final in the absence of a timely appeal by a party for judicial

- 1 review under Subsection (d).
- 2 (d) A party who has exhausted all administrative remedies
- 3 under Section 413.031 and this section and who is aggrieved by a
- 4 final decision of the hearings officer under Subsection (c) may
- 5 seek judicial review of the decision. Judicial review under this
- 6 subsection shall be conducted in the manner provided for judicial
- 7 review of a contested case under Subchapter G, Chapter 2001,
- 8 Government Code.
- 9 <u>(e) The division and the department are not considered to be</u>
- 10 parties to the medical dispute for purposes of this section.
- SECTION 2. Sections 413.031(k) and (1), Labor Code, are
- 12 repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
