4	SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Property Code, is amended by adding
5	Section 12.0011 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 12.0011. INSTRUMENTS CONCERNING PROPERTY: ORIGINAL
7	SIGNATURE REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN INSTRUMENTS. (a) For the purposes
8	of this section, "paper document" means a document received by a
9	county clerk in a form that is not electronic.
10	(b) A paper document concerning real or personal property
11	may not be recorded or serve as notice of the paper document unless:
12	(1) the paper document contains an original signature
13	or signatures that are acknowledged, sworn to with a proper jurat,
14	or proved according to law; or
15	(2) the paper document is attached as an exhibit to a
16	paper affidavit or other document that has an original signature or
17	signatures that are acknowledged, sworn to with a proper jurat, or
18	proved according to law.
19	(c) An original signature may not be required for an
20	electronic instrument or other document that complies with the
21	requirements of Chapter 15 of this code, Chapter 195, Local
22	Government Code, Chapter 43, Business & Commerce Code, or other
23	applicable law.
24	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

a document filed or recorded on or after the effective date of this 1 2 Act. A document filed or recorded before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the document was 3 4 filed or recorded, and that law is continued in effect for that 5 purpose. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
