3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 501.115, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) When a debt or claim secured by a lien has been
8	satisfied <u>:</u>
9	(1) $[\tau]$ the lienholder shall, within a reasonable time
10	not to exceed the maximum time allowed by Section 348.408, Finance
11	Code <u>:</u>
12	(A) $[\tau]$ execute and deliver to the owner, or the
13	owner's designee, a discharge of the lien on a form prescribed by
14	the department; and
15	(B) notify the department by mail, electronic
16	mail, or facsimile transmission of the discharge of the lien; and
17	(2) the department shall record the notification in
18	the motor vehicle records.
19	(c) The form prescribed by the department under Subsection
20	(a) must include a notice that the owner will not receive a new
21	certificate of title with reference to the lien removed unless the
22	owner applies for a new certificate of title as provided by
23	Subsection (b).
24	(d) A notification recorded in the motor vehicle records

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1	under Subsection (a)(2) serves as a discharge of the lien if the
2	form delivered to the owner or owner's designee under Subsection
3	(a)(1)(A) is lost.
4	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
