3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 501.115, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a) When a debt or claim secured by a lien has been
8	satisfied, the lienholder shall, within a reasonable time not to
9	exceed the maximum time allowed by Section 348.408, Finance
10	Code <u>:</u> [7]
11	(1) execute and deliver to the owner, or the owner's
12	designee, a discharge of the lien on a form prescribed by the
13	department; and
14	(2) notify the department of the discharge of the
15	<u>lien</u> .
16	(c) The form prescribed by the department under Subsection
17	(a) must include a notice that the owner will not receive a new
18	certificate of title with reference to the lien removed unless the
19	owner applies for a new certificate of title as provided by
20	Subsection (b).
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
