- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.05, Penal Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 6
- 7 (a-1) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)(2) that: 8
- 9 (1) the person has contacted an appropriate law enforcement official to make arrangements to bring the suspect to 10 11 the official or to a designated law enforcement agency;
- 12 (2) the person and the law enforcement official have agreed to the time and the manner in which the person is to bring the 13 14 suspect to the official or designated agency; and
- (3) the person's actions after contacting the law 15 enforcement official indicate that the person is complying with the 16 terms of the agreement described by Subdivision (2). 17
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 20 21 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 22 23 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 24 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
