- 2 relating to the amount of a late fee under a residential lease.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 92.020 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 92.020. LATE FEES. (a) A landlord may not charge as a
- 7 <u>late fee more than \$150 per month for a tenant's late payment of</u>
- $8 \quad \underline{\text{rent.}}$
- 9 (b) A landlord must give prior written notice to the tenant
- in the lease agreement of the restriction on late fees specified by
- 11 this section.
- 12 (c) A landlord who violates this section is liable to the
- 13 tenant for actual damages, additional damages equal to the amount
- of one month's rent plus \$500, and attorney's fees.
- 15 (d) A provision of a lease that purports to waive a right or
- 16 exempt a party from a liability or duty under this section is void.
- 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 18 a lease or lease agreement that is executed or renewed on or after
- 19 the effective date of this Act. A lease or lease agreement that is
- 20 executed or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 governed by the law in effect at the time the lease or lease
- 22 agreement was executed or renewed, and that law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2008.
