- 5 SECTION 1. Section 481.115(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under Subsection (a) is a <u>Class A misdemeanor</u>
- 8 [state jail felony] if the amount of the controlled substance
- 9 possessed is, by aggregate weight, including adulterants or
- 10 dilutants, less than one gram.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 481.116(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) An offense under Subsection (a) is a <u>Class A misdemeanor</u>
- 14 [state jail felony] if the amount of the controlled substance
- 15 possessed is, by aggregate weight, including adulterants or
- 16 dilutants, less than one gram.
- 17 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2007.
- 19 (b) An offense committed before September 1, 2007, is
- 20 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- this section, an offense was committed before September 1, 2007, if
- 23 any element of the offense was committed before that date.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
