## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 157, Family Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 157.2631 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 157.2631. CREDIT FOR DIRECT PAYMENTS. (a) In this
- 8 section, "direct payment" means a child support payment that is not
- 9 made through the state disbursement unit or another similar
- 10 <u>intermediary</u>, but instead is made by the obligor directly to the
- 11 obligee.
- 12 (b) In confirming the amount of child support arrearages and
- 13 rendering a cumulative money judgment under this subchapter, the
- 14 court shall grant a credit to the obligor equal to the amount of any
- direct payments made by the obligor and acknowledged by the obligee
- in an affidavit executed by the obligee and filed with the court.
- 17 (c) This section is not intended to alter the requirement
- 18 prescribed by Section 154.004 that the court order the payment of
- 19 <u>child support to the state disbursement unit as provided by Chapter</u>
- 20 <u>234</u>.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 157.2631, Family Code, as added by this
- 22 Act, applies to a judgment rendered on or after the effective date
- of this Act. A judgment rendered before the effective date of this
- 24 Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the judgment was

- 1 rendered, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
