In a prosecution for 11 capital murder, evidence of the identification of a suspect in a pre-trial photographic identification procedure is inadmissible as 13 14 unduly suggestive if the procedure:
- 15 (1) is conducted in the presence of a peace officer who is primarily responsible for conducting the investigation of the 16 capital murder; or 17
- 18 (2) consists of presenting to the witness photographs that depict the suspect contemporaneously with photographs that 19 depict_other individuals. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies 22 only to a pre-trial photographic identification procedure, as defined by Article 38.36(c), Code of Criminal Procedure, as added 23 by this Act, that takes place on or after the effective date of this 24

- 2 (b) A pre-trial photographic identification procedure that
- 3 took place before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
- 4 law in effect when the procedure took place, and the former law is
- 5 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
