## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 572.032, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address of a judge
- 8 or justice from a financial statement filed under this subchapter
- 9 before:
- 10 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
- 11 statement; or
- 12 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
- 13 the public.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, applies to a financial statement filed under
- 16 Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, regardless of whether
- 17 the statement was required to be filed before, on, or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
