- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 38.02(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person [he]
- 7 intentionally refuses to give the person's [his] name, residence
- 8 address, or date of birth to a peace officer who has:
- 9 (1) lawfully arrested or lawfully detained the person;
- 10 and
- 11 (2) requested the information.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 16 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 17 this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of
- 18 this Act if any element of the offense occurs before that date.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
