A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the recreational facility fee at The University of

3 Texas at El Paso.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 54.541(a) and (c), Education Code, are

6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (a) The board of regents of The University of Texas System
- 8 may charge each student enrolled at The University of Texas at El
- 9 Paso a recreational facility fee not to exceed \$70 [\$12] per student
- 10 for a term or semester of 10 weeks or more or \$50 for any other term
- or semester [per semester or summer session]. The fee may be used
- 12 only for financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, and
- 13 improving new and existing recreational sports facilities and
- 14 programs at The University of Texas at El Paso.
- 15 (c) The recreational facility fee may not be <u>increased</u>
- 16 [levied] unless the amount of the increase [fee] is approved [and
- 17 the amount of the fee is set] by \underline{a} majority vote of those students
- 18 participating in a general student election called at The
- 19 University of Texas at El Paso for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 21 fees charged beginning with the 2007 fall semester. A fee charged
- for a term or semester before the 2007 fall semester is covered by
- 23 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
