11	felony of the second degree. An offense under Subsection (d)(2) is a									
12	Class A misdemeanor.									
13	(d) A person commits an offense if the person:									
14	(1) knowing that an offense has been committed,									
15	alters, destroys, or conceals any record, document, or thing with									
16	intent to impair its verity, legibility, or availability as									
17	evidence in any subsequent investigation of or official proceeding									
18	related to the offense; or									
19	(2) observes <u>a</u> human <u>corpse</u> [remains] under									
20	circumstances in which a reasonable person would believe that an									
21	offense had been committed, knows or reasonably should know that a									
22	law enforcement agency is not aware of the existence of or location									
23	of the <u>corpse</u> [remains], and fails to report the existence of and									
24	location of the <u>corpse</u> [remains] to a law enforcement agency.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 5 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed, 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 7 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 8 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 9 committed before that date. 10
