A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the prosecution of and punishment for the offense of

3 tampering with or fabricating physical evidence.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 37.09, Penal Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read

7 as follows:

- 8 (c) An offense under Subsection (a) or Subsection (d)(1) is
- 9 a felony of the third degree, unless the thing altered, destroyed,
- 10 or concealed is a human corpse, in which case the offense is a
- 11 felony of the second degree. An offense under Subsection (d)(2) is a
- 12 Class A misdemeanor.
- 13 (d) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 14 (1) knowing that an offense has been committed,
- 15 alters, destroys, or conceals any record, document, or thing with
- 16 intent to impair its verity, legibility, or availability as
- 17 evidence in any subsequent investigation of or official proceeding
- 18 related to the offense; or
- 19 (2) observes a human corpse [remains] under
- 20 circumstances in which a reasonable person would believe that an
- 21 offense had been committed, knows or reasonably should know that a
- law enforcement agency is not aware of the existence of or location
- of the corpse [remains], and fails to report the existence of and
- location of the corpse [remains] to a law enforcement agency.

- (e) In this section, "human corpse" has the meaning assigned
- 2 <u>by Section 42.08.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 10 committed before that date.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
