3 (e) An offense under [Subdivision (1) or (5) of] Subsection
4 (a)(4) or (5) [(a)] is a Class A misdemeanor. An offense under
5 [Subdivision (2), (3), or (4) of] Subsection (a)(1), (2), or (3)
6 [(a)] is a state jail felony. [An offense under Subdivision (6) of

8 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 9 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 10 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 12 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 13 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 14 15 date.
