A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to requiring that a driver's license, personal

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Subsections (c-1) and (d-1) to read as follows:
- 9 (c-1) The department shall include on the face of a personal
- 10 identification certificate a statement as to whether the holder is
- 11 a citizen of the United States.
- 12 (d-1) Unless proof of an applicant's United States
- 13 <u>citizenship has been previously provided to the department, the</u>
- 14 department shall require each applicant for an original, renewal,
- or duplicate personal identification certificate to furnish to the
- department the information required by Section 521.142(b)(5).
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 521.121(a), Transportation Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 (a) The driver's license must include:
- 20 (1) a distinguishing number assigned by the department
- 21 to the license holder;
- 22 (2) a color photograph of the entire face of the
- 23 holder;
- 24 (3) the full name, date of birth, and residence

- 1 address of the holder; [and]
- 2 (4) a brief description of the holder; and
- 3 (5) a statement as to whether the holder is a citizen
- 4 of the United States.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (i) and (j) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) The application must include:
- 9 (1) the thumbprints of the applicant or, if
- 10 thumbprints cannot be taken, the index fingerprints of the
- 11 applicant;
- 12 (2) a photograph of the applicant;
- 13 (3) the signature of the applicant; [and]
- 14 (4) a brief description of the applicant; and
- 15 (5) proof of the applicant's United States citizenship
- or authorization to be in the United States.
- 17 (i) The department shall accept as proof of an applicant's
- 18 United States citizenship:
- 19 (1) an original or certified copy of a birth
- 20 certificate issued to the applicant that verifies United States
- 21 citizenship as determined by department rule; or
- 22 (2) a valid United States passport issued to the
- 23 <u>applicant.</u>
- 24 (j) An applicant who is not a citizen of the United States
- 25 must present to the department documentation issued by the federal
- 26 agency responsible for citizenship and immigration authorizing the
- 27 applicant to be in the United States.

- 1 SECTION 4. Section 521.1425, Transportation Code, is
- 2 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> (b) and (c)
- 5 [Subsection (b)], the department may require each applicant for an
- 6 original, renewal, or duplicate driver's license to furnish to the
- 7 department the information required by Section 521.142.
- 8 <u>(c) Unless proof of an applicant's United States</u>
- 9 citizenship has been previously provided to the department, the
- 10 department shall require each applicant for a renewal or duplicate
- 11 license to furnish to the department the information required by
- 12 Section 521.142(b)(5).
- SECTION 5. Section 522.021(a), Transportation Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) An application for a commercial driver's license or
- 16 commercial driver learner's permit must include:
- 17 (1) the full name and current residence and mailing
- 18 address of the applicant;
- 19 (2) a physical description of the applicant, including
- 20 sex, height, and eye color;
- 21 (3) the applicant's date of birth;
- 22 (4) the applicant's social security number, unless the
- 23 application is for a nonresident commercial driver's license and
- the applicant is a resident of a foreign jurisdiction;
- 25 (5) certifications, including those required by 49
- 26 C.F.R. Section 383.71(a); [and]
- 27 (6) the information required by Section

- 1 SECTION 7. Section 522.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 2 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 3 (h) Unless proof of an applicant's United States
- 4 citizenship has been previously provided to the department, the
- 5 department shall require each applicant for a renewal or duplicate
- 6 commercial driver's license to furnish to the department the
- 7 <u>information required by Section 521.142(b)(5).</u>
- 8 SECTION 8. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 9 to:
- 10 (1) an application for an original, renewal, or
- 11 duplicate application for a personal identification certificate,
- 12 driver's license, or commercial driver's license submitted on or
- 13 after the effective date of this Act; and
- 14 (2) an original, renewal, or duplicate personal
- 15 identification certificate, driver's license, or commercial
- driver's license issued on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
