A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- relating to market power abuse in the wholesale electricity market; 2 providing administrative and civil penalties.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 15.023(b), Utilities Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- (b) The penalty for a violation, except for a violation 7
- under Section 39.157, may be in an amount not to exceed \$25,000. 8
- Each day a violation continues or occurs is a separate violation for 9
- purposes of imposing a penalty. The penalty for a violation under 10
- Section 39.157 is not more than \$200,000, and the classification 11
- 12 system established under Subsection (c) does not apply to the
- violation. 13

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- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 15, Utilities Code, is
- amended by adding Section 15.0291 to read as follows: 15
- 16 Sec. 15.0291. CIVIL PENALTY FOR VIOLATING SECTION 39.157.
- (a) A person who violates Section 39.157 or a rule adopted or order 17
- issued by the commission under that section is subject to a civil 18
- penalty of not less than \$100,000 and not more than \$250,000 for 19
- each violation. 20
- 21 (b) A civil penalty under this section is recoverable in a
- suit filed in the name of the commission by the attorney general on 22
- 23 the attorney general's own initiative or at the request of the
- 24 commission.

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- SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a violation committed on or after September 1, 2007. For purposes of this section, a violation is committed before September 1, 2007, if any element of the violation occurs before that date.
- 5 (b) A violation committed before September 1, 2007, is 6 covered by the law in effect when the violation was committed, and 7 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
