4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 228.054(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the operator of a
8	vehicle, other than an authorized emergency vehicle, as defined by
9	Section 541.201, that is driven or towed through a toll collection
10	facility shall pay the proper toll. The exemption from payment of a
11	toll for an authorized emergency vehicle applies regardless of
12	whether the vehicle is:
13	(1) responding to an emergency;
14	(2) displaying a flashing light; or
15	(3) marked as an emergency vehicle.
16	SECTION 2. Section 284.070, Transportation Code, is amended
17	by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
18	(e) An authorized emergency vehicle, as defined by Section
19	541.201, is exempt from payment of a toll imposed under this chapter
20	regardless of whether the vehicle is:
21	(1) responding to an emergency;
22	(2) displaying a flashing light; or
23	(3) marked as an emergency vehicle.

5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
