## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to an exemption from the payment of a toll for an

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 228.054(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the operator of a
- 8 vehicle, other than an authorized emergency vehicle, that is driven
- 9 or towed through a toll collection facility shall pay the proper
- 10 toll. The exemption from payment of a toll for an authorized
- 11 emergency vehicle applies regardless of whether the vehicle is
- 12 responding to an emergency or displaying a flashing light.
- SECTION 2. Section 284.070, Transportation Code, is amended
- 14 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) An authorized emergency vehicle is exempt from payment
- of a toll imposed under this chapter regardless of whether the
- 17 vehicle is responding to an emergency or displaying a flashing
- 18 <u>light.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 366.178(a), Transportation Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) A motor vehicle other than a police or emergency vehicle
- 22 that passes through a toll collection facility, whether driven or
- 23 towed, shall pay the proper toll. The exemption from payment of a
- 24 toll for a police or emergency vehicle applies regardless of

- 1 whether the vehicle is responding to an emergency or displaying a
- 2 flashing light.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 370.177(a), Transportation Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the operator of
- 6 a vehicle, other than an authorized emergency vehicle as defined by
- 7 Section 541.201, that is driven or towed through a toll collection
- 8 facility of a turnpike project shall pay the proper toll. The
- 9 operator of a vehicle who drives or tows a vehicle through a toll
- 10 collection facility and does not pay the proper toll commits an
- 11 offense. An offense under this subsection is a misdemeanor
- 12 punishable by a fine not to exceed \$250. The exemption from payment
- of a toll for an authorized emergency vehicle applies regardless of
- 14 whether the vehicle is responding to an emergency or displaying a
- 15 flashing light.
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
