| 7 | amended by adding Section 30.0035 to read as follows: |
| 8 | Sec. 30.0035. TESTIMONY OR DEPOSITION OF MEMBER OF |
| 9 | LEGISLATURE. (a) In this section, "contested case" has the meaning |
| 10 | provided by Section 2001.003, Government Code. |
| 11 | (b) This section applies to: |
| 12 | (1) a civil suit, including a matter of probate or |
| 13 | condemnation proceeding, and to any matter ancillary to a civil |
| 14 | suit at which the testimony of a witness may be taken or in which a |
| 15 | person may be required to give a deposition; and |
| 16 | (2) a contested case before a state agency. |

- 17 (c) This section does not apply to a member of the legislature who is a party to the suit or contested case in which 18 19 the person is called to testify or give a deposition.
- (d) At any time when the legislature is in session, on 20 21 application of a member of the legislature who has been called, by subpoena or other method, to testify as a witness or to give a 22 23 deposition in a suit or contested case to which this section 24 applies, or who in discovery has been named as a potential witness

- 1 by a party to the suit or contested case, the court in which the suit
- 2 is pending or the official conducting the contested case hearing,
- 3 as applicable, shall <u>excuse the member from being compelled to</u>
- 4 testify as a witness or to give a deposition as provided by this

- 6 (e) A member of the legislature seeking to be excused under
- 7 this section must file a request for the excuse with the court in
- 8 which the suit is pending or with the official conducting the
- 9 contested case hearing, as applicable. On receipt of the request,
- 10 the court or official shall excuse the member from being compelled
- 11 to give testimony or a deposition in the suit or contested case
- 12 until a time and place agreed to by the member or until a date not
- 13 earlier than the fifth day after the date the legislative session
- 14 ends.
- 15 (f) This section does not diminish or affect any immunity or
- 16 privilege of a member of the legislature under other law, including
- 17 the constitution or common law.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
