- 2 relating to funding for career and technology programs in public

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 42.154(a) and (c), Education Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily
- 8 attendance in an approved career and technology education program
- 9 in grades $\underline{\text{seven}}$ [$\underline{\text{nine}}$] through 12, including $\underline{\text{a}}$ [$\underline{\text{or in}}$] career and
- 10 technology education program [programs] for students with
- 11 disabilities [in grades seven through 12], a district is entitled
- 12 to an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic allotment
- multiplied by a weight of 1.35.
- 14 (c) Funds allocated under this section, other than an
- indirect cost allotment established under State Board of Education
- 16 rule, must be used in providing career and technology education
- 17 programs in grades <u>seven</u> [nine] through 12, including [or] career
- and technology education programs for students with disabilities,
- 19 [in grades seven through 12] under Sections 29.182, 29.183, and
- 20 29.184.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
