BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 201.001(b), Property Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (b) The provisions of this chapter relating to extension of 8 the term of, renewal of, or creation of restrictions do not apply to 9 a subdivision if, by the express terms of the instrument creating 10 existing restrictions, some or all of the restrictions affecting 11 the real property within the subdivision provide:

12 (1) for automatic extensions of the term of the 13 restrictions for an indefinite number of successive specified 14 periods <u>of at least 10 years</u> subject to a right of waiver or 15 termination, in whole or in part, by a specified percentage of less 16 than 50 percent plus one of the owners of real property interests in 17 the subdivision, as set forth in the instrument creating the 18 restrictions; or

19 (2) for an indefinite number of successive extensions 20 <u>of at least 10 years</u> of the term of the restrictions by written and 21 filed agreement of a specified percentage of less than 50 percent 22 plus one of the owners of real property interests in the 23 subdivision, as authorized by the instrument creating the 24 restrictions.

(a) A petition may be filed under this chapter to<u>:</u>

- 4 (1) extend or renew an unexpired restriction;
 - (2) [, to] create a restriction;

6 <u>(3)</u> [, or to] add to or modify an existing restriction;
7 <u>or</u>

8 <u>(4) modify an existing provision in an instrument</u> 9 <u>creating a restriction that provides for extension of those</u> 10 <u>restrictions</u>.

SECTION 3. Section 204.003, Property Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 204.003. APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS OF RESTRICTIVE 13 COVENANTS [PREVAIL] IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES. 14 (a) An express 15 designation in a document creating restrictions applicable to a residential real estate subdivision that provides for the extension 16 17 of, addition to, or modification of existing restrictions by a designated number of owners of real property in the subdivision 18 prevails over the provisions of this chapter. 19

20 (b) A document creating restrictions that provides for the 21 extension or renewal of restrictions and does not provide for 22 modification or amendment of restrictions may be modified under 23 this chapter, including modifying the provision that provides for 24 extension or renewal of the restrictions.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
