A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the amendment or extension of restrictive covenants on
- 3 residential property.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 201.001(b), Property Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The provisions of this chapter relating to extension of
- 8 the term of, renewal of, or creation of restrictions do not apply to
- 9 a subdivision if, by the express terms of the instrument creating
- 10 existing restrictions, some or all of the restrictions affecting
- 11 the real property within the subdivision provide:
- 12 (1) for automatic extensions of the term of the
- 13 restrictions for an indefinite number of successive specified
- 14 periods of at least 10 years subject to a right of waiver or
- termination, in whole or in part, by a specified percentage of less
- than 50 percent plus one of the owners of real property interests in
- 17 the subdivision, as set forth in the instrument creating the
- 18 restrictions; or
- 19 (2) for an indefinite number of successive extensions
- 20 of at least 10 years of the term of the restrictions by written and
- 21 filed agreement of a specified percentage of less than 50 percent
- 22 plus one of the owners of real property interests in the
- 23 subdivision, as authorized by the instrument creating the
- 24 restrictions.

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1 SECTION 2. Sections 201.004(a) and (c), Property Code, are 2 amended to read as follows:

- 3 (a) A petition may be filed under this chapter to:
- 4 (1) extend or renew an unexpired restriction;
- 5 (2) [, to] create a restriction;
- 6 (3) [, or to] add to or modify an existing restriction;
- 7 <u>or</u>
- 8 (4) modify an existing provision in an instrument
- 9 creating a restriction that provides for extension of those
- 10 <u>restrictions</u>.
- 11 (c) If a petition meeting the requirements of this chapter
- 12 is filed with the county clerk within the required period, the
- 13 provisions of the petition extending, renewing, creating, adding
- 14 to, or modifying a restriction apply to and burden all of the
- 15 property in the subdivision except property excluded under Section
- 16 201.009. If a petition contains provisions extending or renewing
- 17 the term of a restriction, the petition may provide for an initial
- 18 extension or renewal period of not more than 30 $[\frac{10}{10}]$ years and
- 19 additional automatic extensions of the term for not more than 30
- 20 [10] years each. The extension, renewal, creation, or modification
- of, or addition to, a restriction takes effect on the later of the
- 22 dates the petition is filed with the county clerk or a date
- 23 specified in the petition.
- SECTION 3. Section 204.003, Property Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- Sec. 204.003. APPLICATION OF PROVISIONS OF RESTRICTIVE
- 27 COVENANTS [PREVAIL] IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES. (a) An express

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- 1 designation in a document creating restrictions applicable to a
- 2 residential real estate subdivision that provides for the extension
- 3 of, addition to, or modification of existing restrictions by a
- 4 designated number of owners of real property in the subdivision
- 5 prevails over the provisions of this chapter.
- 6 (b) A document creating restrictions that provides for the
- 7 <u>extension or renewal of restrictions and does not provide for</u>
- 8 modification or amendment of restrictions may be modified under
- 9 this chapter, including modifying the provision that provides for
- 10 extension or renewal of the restrictions.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
