- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 542.203, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 542.203. LIMITATIONS [LIMITATION] ON LOCAL
- 9 AUTHORITIES.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 542.203, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 12 (d) A local authority may not implement or operate an
- 13 <u>automated traffic-control system with respect to a highway under</u>
- 14 its jurisdiction. The attorney general shall enforce this
- 15 subsection.
- 16 (e) In this section, "automated traffic-control system"
- 17 means a system consisting of one or more photographic devices,
- 18 radar devices, laser devices, or other electrical or mechanical
- 19 devices that:
- 20 <u>(1) is capable of producing one or more recorded</u>
- 21 photographic or digital images depicting the license plate attached
- 22 to the front or rear of a motor vehicle that is not operated in
- 23 compliance with posted speed limits or the instructions of a
- 24 traffic-control signal; and

- (2) is used by the local authority to enforce 1 2 compliance with posted speed limits or the instructions of a traffic-control signal by imposition of a civil or administrative 3 penalty against the owner or operator of the motor vehicle.
- SECTION 3. Section 542.202(b)(3), Transportation Code, is 5 6 repealed.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
