- 8 MUNICIPALITIES. (a) Not later than the last day of the month

- 10 (1) compute the amount of revenue derived from the

- 12 percent and received from hotels located on barrier islands in an
- 13 eligible <u>barrier island</u> [<u>general-law</u>] coastal municipality; and
- 14 (2) issue to the eligible <u>barrier island</u> [<del>general-law</del>]
- 15 coastal municipality a warrant drawn on the general revenue fund in
- the amount computed under Subdivision (1).
- 17 (b) An eligible <u>barrier island</u> [<del>general-law</del>] coastal
- 18 municipality may use money received under this section only:
- 19 (1) to clean and maintain public beaches in that

- 1 municipality" means a [general-law] municipality:
- 2 (A) [that has a population of less than 5,000;
- 3  $\left[\frac{\text{(B)}}{\text{)}}\right]$  that borders on the Gulf of Mexico;
- 4 (B) that is located wholly or partly on a barrier
- 5 island; and
- 6 (C) the boundaries of which are within 30 miles
- 7 of the United Mexican States or include a portion of a national
- 8 seashore.
- 9 (2) "Clean and maintain" has the meaning assigned by
- 10 Section 61.063, Natural Resources Code.
- 11 (3) "Erosion response project" has the meaning
- 12 assigned by Section 33.601, Natural Resources Code.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
