- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 191.0525, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:
- 7 (j) This section does not apply to recreational metal
- 8 detecting in designated areas of state parks.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 13, Parks and Wildlife
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Section 13.1021 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 13.1021. REGULATION OF RECREATIONAL METAL DETECTING IN
- 12 STATE PARKS. (a) The department shall allow recreational metal
- 13 <u>detecting in designated areas of state parks subject to rules</u>
- 14 adopted by the commission.
- 15 (b) This section does not authorize the removal from state
- 16 park land of any object, implement, or artifact the removal of which
- is prohibited under Chapter 191, Natural Resources Code.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2008.
