The 14 panel shall include in its recommendations its] determination of the reasonableness of the proposed amounts of funding. 15 16 (d) The commission must approve a grant of \$500 or more. The commission by rule may delegate the authority to approve a grant of 17 18 less than \$500 to the executive director. The commission shall review a grant approved by the executive director at the 19 commission's next regular meeting after the approval. 20 21 (e) [(c)] The commission by rule shall adopt equitable 22 procedures for the distribution of grants to recipients who reflect the geographical, cultural, and ethnic diversity of the state's 23 24 population.
