A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (c-3) and (c-4) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The salary factors per step are as follows:

- 18 Salary Factor $\underline{1.0773}$ $[\underline{1.009}]$
- 19 <u>(c-3)</u> Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2007-2008 20 <u>school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time</u> 21 <u>counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse</u> 22 is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of:
- (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
- 24 received for the 2007-2008 school year under the district's salary

- schedule for the 2006-2007 school year, if that schedule had been in
- 2 effect for the 2007-2008 school year, including any local
- 3 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
- 4 the employee would have received in the 2007-2008 school year; and
- 5 (2) \$300.
- 6 (c-4) Subsection (c-3) and this subsection expire September
 7 1, 2008.
- 8 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 9 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
- 10 employed by a school district in the 2007-2008 [2006-2007] school
- 11 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,
- 12 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the
- employee received for the 2007-2008 [$\frac{2006-2007}{2008}$] school year.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 42.2518 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 42.2518. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST
- 17 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 18 school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 19 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state
- 20 aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the
- 21 product of \$3,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers,
- 22 full-time librarians, full-time counselors certified under
- 23 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by
- the district and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402.
- 25 (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 26 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which

- 1 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- 2 amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 3 <u>attendance credits.</u>
- 4 (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 5 <u>is final and may not be appealed.</u>
- 6 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 7 section.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 9 school year.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
