6	SECTION 1. Section 105.003, Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to

9	(c) At a minimum, the data collected by the council must
10	include the following in regard to each health professional
11	[professionals]:
12	(1) full name and last four digits of social security
13	number;
14	(2) certification, registration, or licensure
15	information, including certification, registration, or license
16	number, issuance date, method of certification, registration, or
17	licensure, and certification, registration, or licensure status;
18	(3) biographical information, including sex, race or
19	ethnicity, date and place of birth, and full primary mailing

21	(4) educational background and training, including
22	high school location, highest professional degree obtained,

(5) practice information, including primary specialty

- 1 practice, any additional practice with percentage of professional

- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
