- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Emily Lastinger Act.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (b), (d), and (e) and adding Subsection (b-1)
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (b) Subject to Subsection (c), the Department of State
- 10 [Texas Board of] Health Services may modify or delete any of the

- 7 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 38.019 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 38.019. IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS PROGRAM. (a) A school
- 10 <u>district that maintains an Internet website shall post prominently</u>
- on the website a list of:

- school by rules of the Department of State Health Services adopted

- 15 (2) any immunizations or vaccines recommended for

- 2 SECTION 4. Section 38.019, Education Code, as added by this
- 3 Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
