- 2 relating to an immunization awareness program in certain school districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.019 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 38.019. IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS PROGRAM. (a) A school
- 8 district that maintains an Internet website shall post prominently
- 9 on the website a list of:
- 10 (1) the immunizations required for admission to public
- 11 school by rules of the Department of State Health Services adopted
- 12 under Section 38.001;

- 13 (2) any immunizations, in addition to immunizations
- 14 listed under Subdivision (1), required for admission to public
- school by the board of trustees of the district;
- 16 (3) any immunizations or vaccines recommended for
- 17 public school students by the Department of State Health Services
- or the board of trustees of the district; and
- 19 <u>(4) health clinics in the district that offer the</u>
- 20 influenza vaccine.
- 21 (b) The list of recommended immunizations or vaccines under
- 22 Subsection (a)(3) must include the influenza vaccine, unless the
- 23 Department of State Health Services or board of trustees requires
- the influenza vaccine for admission to public school.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 38.019, Education Code, as added by this
- 2 Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
