AN ACT

2 relating to the use of electronically readable information from a 3 driver's license or personal identification certificate by certain 4 health care providers and hospitals.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 SECTION 1. Section 521.126, Transportation Code, is amended
 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (i) to read as

8 follows:

9 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (d), (e), [and] (g),
10 and (i), a person commits an offense if the person:

(1) accesses or uses electronically readable information derived from a driver's license, commercial driver's license, or personal identification certificate; or

14 (2) compiles or maintains a database of electronically
 15 readable information derived from driver's licenses, commercial
 16 driver's licenses, or personal identification certificates.

17 (i) The prohibition provided by Subsection (b)(1) does not 18 apply to a hospital that accesses or uses the information that is 19 printed on the license or personal identification certificate to 20 complete a form that is required to provide health care services to 21 the individual who holds the driver's license, commercial driver's 22 license, or personal identification certificate.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
