9	JAIL DEFENDANTS. (a) The department shall adopt a policy that:
LO	(1) allows any nonprofit or public health care agency
L1	to distribute condoms to inmates and state jail defendants confined
L2	in facilities operated by or under contract with the department;

L4	(2) provides for the disposal of used condoms in a
L5	manner that protects:
L6	(A) the anonymity of inmates and state jail
L7	defendants; and
L8	(B) the health of department employees, inmates,
L9	and state jail defendants.
20	(b) Possession of a condom distributed in accordance with
21	the policy adopted under Subsection (a) may not be used as evidence
22	of illegal activity for purposes of administrative sanctions
