- 10 electronic communications of an administrative law judge at the
- 11 State Office of Administrative Hearings are excepted from the
- 12 requirements of Section 552.021:
- 13 (1) notes <u>and electronic communications</u> recording the
- 14 observations, thoughts, questions, deliberations, or impressions
- of an administrative law judge;
- 16 (2) drafts of a proposal for decision;
- 17 (3) drafts of orders made in connection with
- 18 conducting contested case hearings; and
- 19 (4) drafts of orders made in connection with
- 20 conducting alternative dispute resolution procedures.
