## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to safety regulations for certain contract carriers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 644.054, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) The department shall adopt rules regulating the
- 8 operation of a contract carrier to which this section applies. The
- 9 rules must:
- 10 (1) prohibit a person from operating a vehicle for
- 11 more than 12 hours in a day;
- 12 (2) require a person who operates a vehicle for the
- 13 number of consecutive hours or days the department determines is
- 14 excessive to rest for a period determined by the department;
- 15 (3) require a contract carrier to keep a record of all
- 16 hours a vehicle subject to regulation under this section is
- 17 operated; [and]
- 18 (4) require a contract carrier to perform alcohol and
- 19 drug testing of vehicle operators on employment, on suspicion of
- 20 <u>alcohol or drug abuse</u>, and periodically as determined by the
- 21 department;
- 22 <u>(5) require a contract carrier, at a minimum, to</u>
- 23 maintain liability insurance in the amount of \$1.5 million for each
- 24 vehicle;

1	(6) require a person who operates a vehicle to hold a
2	commercial driver's license under Chapter 522; and
3	(7) be determined by the department to be necessary to
4	protect the safety of a passenger being transported or the general
5	public.
6	(c) The department shall inform contract carriers and
7	railroad companies that employ contract carriers of the
8	requirements of state statutes applicable to contract carriers.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
