- 10 physician assistant at least <u>once every 10 business days</u> [20

- 12 (2) reviews at least 10 percent of the medical charts
- 13 at the site; and
- 14 (3) is available through direct telecommunication for
- 15 consultation, patient referral, or assistance with a medical
- 16 emergency.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
