## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting immunization against human papilloma virus
- 3 as a condition for admission to public school.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) Subject to <u>Subsections (b-1) and [Subsection]</u> (c), the
- 9 Texas Board of Health may modify or delete any of the immunizations
- 10 in Subsection (a) or may require immunizations against additional
- 11 diseases as a requirement for admission to any elementary or
- 12 secondary school.
- 13 (b-1) Immunization against the human papilloma virus may
- 14 not be required for a person's admission to any elementary or
- 15 secondary school. This subsection preempts all contrary executive
- orders of the governor.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 22 legislative session.
